NEW RATES TO BE IMPLEMENTED FOR GARBAGE and RECYCLING COLLECTION

Due to the increasing costs for the collection of your weekly garbage and monthly recycling, the City of Westby will be implementing the following price increases effective February 1, 2025.

- ** The monthly fee for garbage collection will be increased from \$12.00 to \$15.00.
- ** The cost per pound for dumpster charges will be raised from \$.07/lb. to \$.10/lb. The drop fee of \$25.00 for the rental of a dumpster will not change.

NOTE: These increases will be effective February 1, 2025, and will reflect on the utility bill you receive in March.

As you prepare for winter and brace yourself for winter storms, make sure you are aware of your surroundings whenever venturing outside. Heavy winds, snowfall, and ice are capable of knocking down utility poles and power lines. If you encounter a downed line, be sure to stay at least 35 feet back, which is about three car lengths. Do not touch the power line or anything in contact with the line. If others are around, warn them to stay away, then call 911. Always consider all downed lines live and dangerous.
