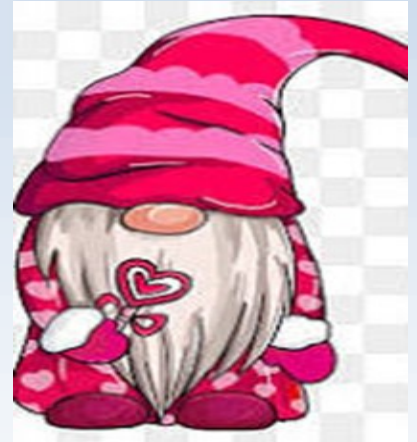

You may be eligible for an Energy Efficient Home Improvement Credit covering up to 30% of energy-efficient home upgrades (e.g., insulation, furnaces, heat pumps, and more). Plus, you can take advantage of the Residential Clean Energy Property Credit, which provides up to a 30% income tax credit for the purchase and installation of clean energy equipment. There are annual limits on the amount and combination of tax credits a taxpayer can claim. Please visit the [IRS website](#) for more information. Focus on Energy rebates are separate from tax credits, and you are encouraged to take advantage of both!
